THE DIRECTORS

Matt LaBranche is in his 11th year as the Head Baseball Coach and Instructor of Physical Education at Western New England College. He led the team in hitting his senior year with an impressive .385 average. His teams won two conference titles during his playing days, and he was named the College Scholar-Athlete of the Year his senior season. Matt has also worked as an assistant baseball coach at the University of Massachusetts, Springfield College and American International College. He also served as Associate Head Coach in the Northeast Collegiate Baseball League and as an assistant in the Cape Cod League with the Chatham A's.

He has both undergraduate and graduate degrees from Springfield College in Health Fitness and Physical Education, respectively. Prior to his appointment at Springfield College, Simeone was the Head Baseball Coach for four years at American International College and spent two years each as an assistant coach at Springfield and at Amherst College. Throughout his playing and coaching career, Simeone has had extensive experience in camp instruction in New England and Canada.
